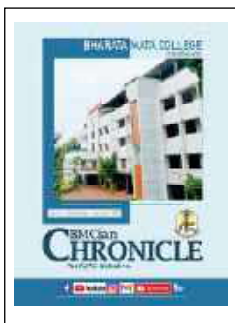

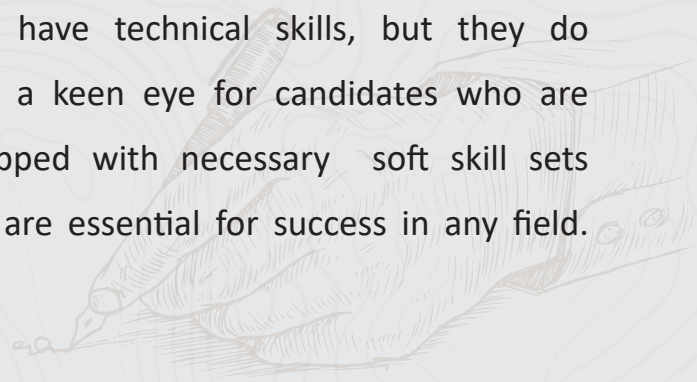

VICE PRINCIPAL (SF)

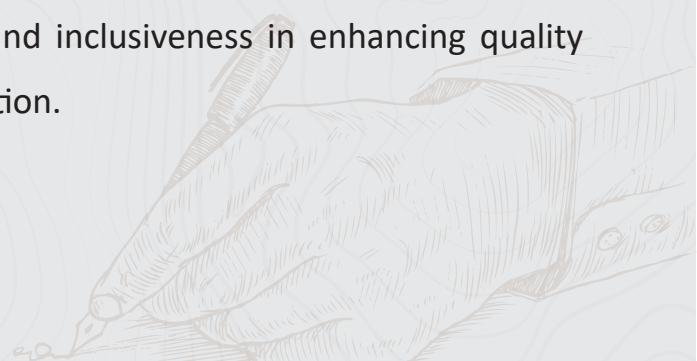
