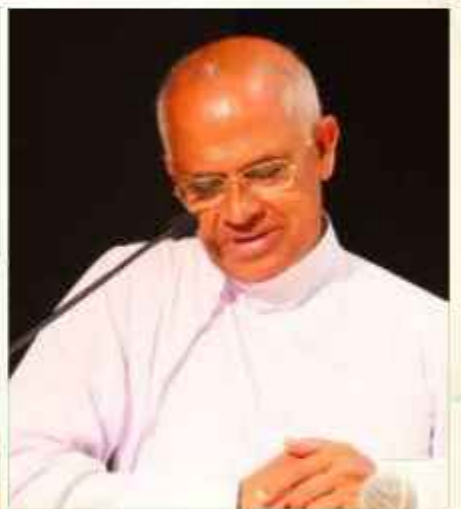
Annual Gathering for Academic Moulding

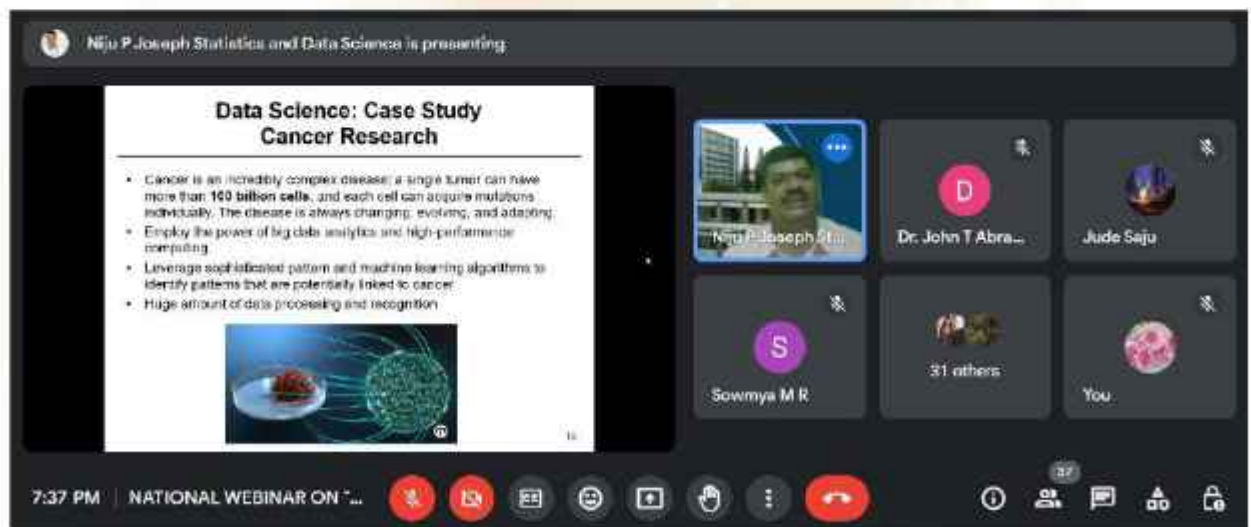



The program was undoubtedly a resounding success, fostering a greater understanding of various scientific concepts while encouraging collaborative thinking among the participants.



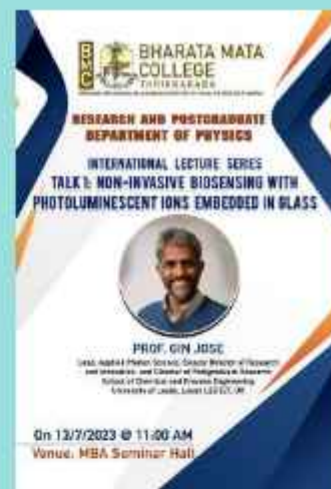

re-writing competition which was open to both school and college students. This competition encouraged participants from across India to reimagine and reshape story endings.

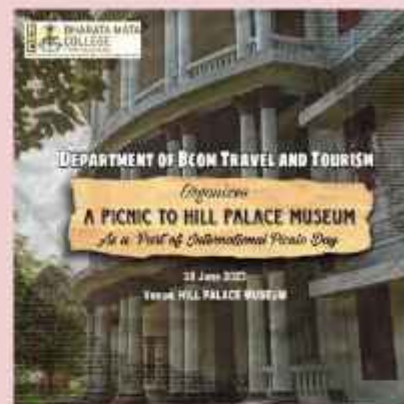

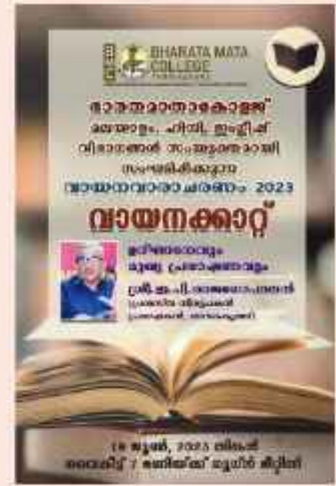
