
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


"AGNEYAM" - 2023 - MSW Vidyarambham Ceremony





The Library, Bharata Mata College organized a One-Day Workshop on Bibliometric Analysis on 07th October 2023 at Audio Visual Room from 9.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m.

Ms.Jaisha V.J. welcomed the Keynote Speaker of the day Mr.Jobin Jose, Librarian, Marian College Kuttikkanam (Autonomous), and Principal of Bharata Mata College and all participants.

Dr.Johnson K.M., Principal inaugurated the programme and he conveyed that Bibliometrics is the basic quantitative analysis of the published scientific literature, so it is significant in every research and in the information explosion era. Bibliometrics is helpful in finding the current trends of one's research area is important and understanding all such metrices like scientometrics, webometrics, infometrics and altmetrics are essential, he added.





Mr.Jobin Jose has more than 20 years of service as a librarian and several workshops related to scholarly publishing are conducting in collaboration with various academic libraries in Kerala.

The workshop ended at 4.00 p.m. with a vote of thanks by Ms.Greety Toms, Librarian, Bharata Mata College.






