The Department of Economics was introduced in our college in the year 1970 with a sanctioned strength of 40 students. The former faculty members of the department are Prof K.E Antony, Sr Carmelita Parackal, Prof C.M Joseph, Prof K.A Kuruvila, Prof Jose Thomas, Dr K.J Giles, Dr P.L. Chackochan, Prof Ransamma Paul, Rev Fr George Athappilly, Dr M.T Antony, Dr Kochurani Thomas. At present there is 1 permanent faculty and 3 guest faculty members in the Department. To our great reputation, about 9 publications by the faculty members in national/international journals/edited books during 2015-22.

The Department currently has 136 students. The students of the department perform well in university exams bagging university ranks. During 2020-21, the department could produce one rank, 1 A+ and 6 A grade holders. The students of the department have placement records too. During 2021-22, two students were placed in reputed companies.

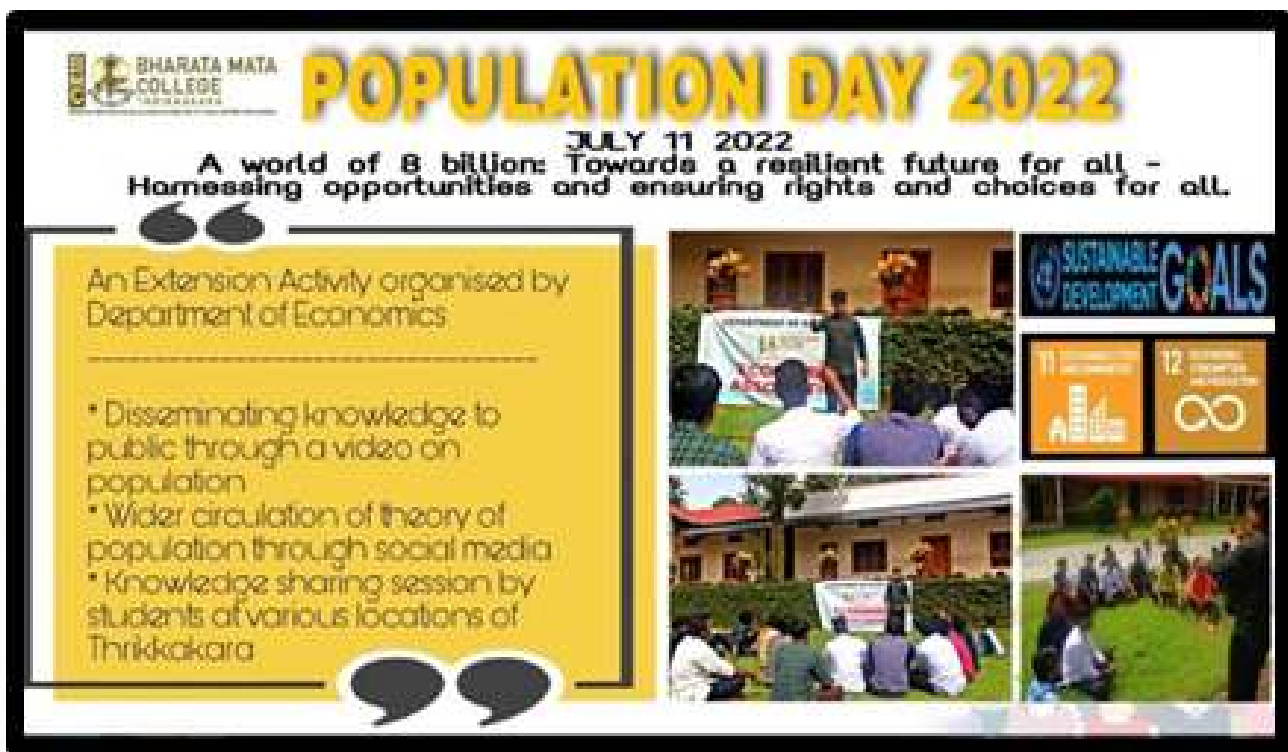
# World Population Day

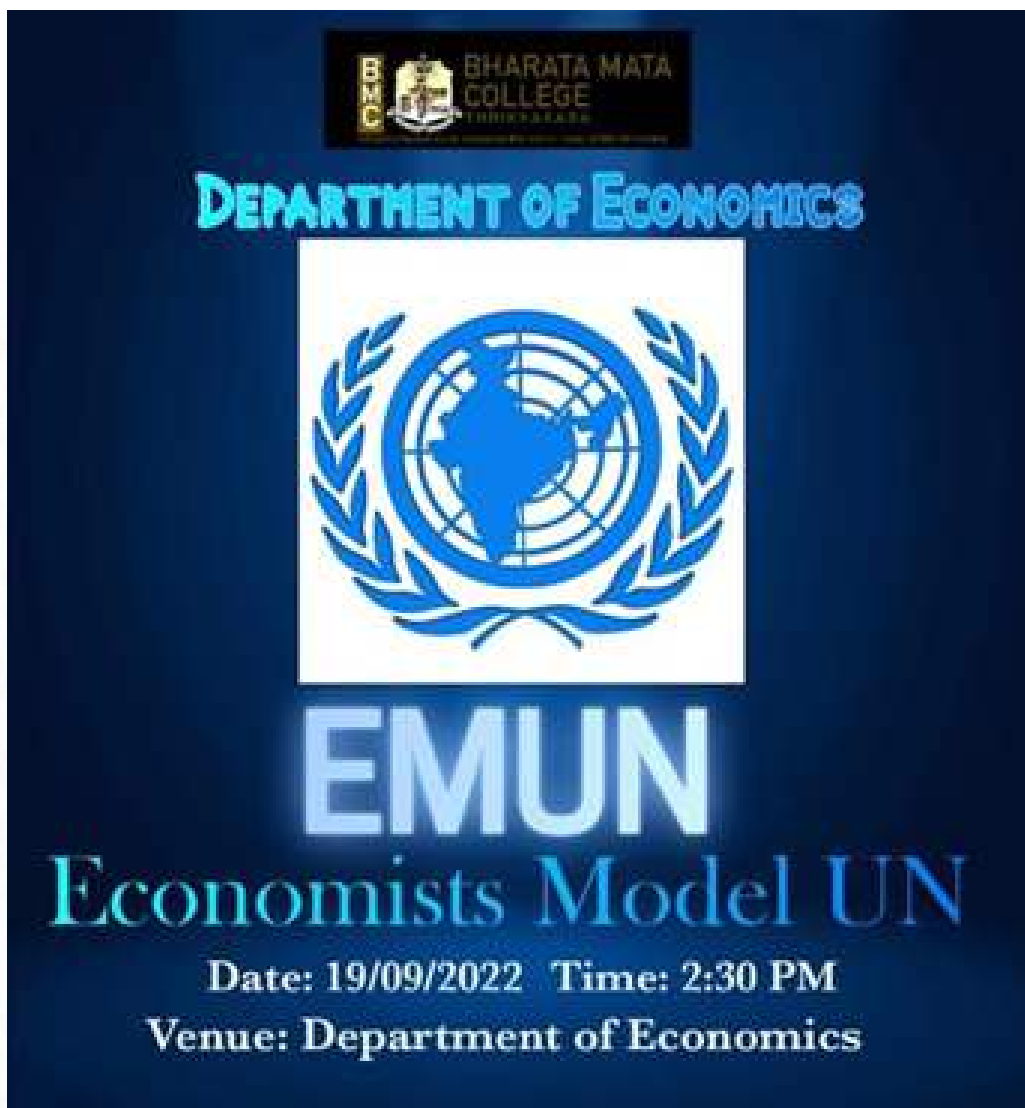
## ***EMUN- Economics Model UN***

## ***NISM Sponsored Two Days Workshop on Financial Education for Young Citizens***

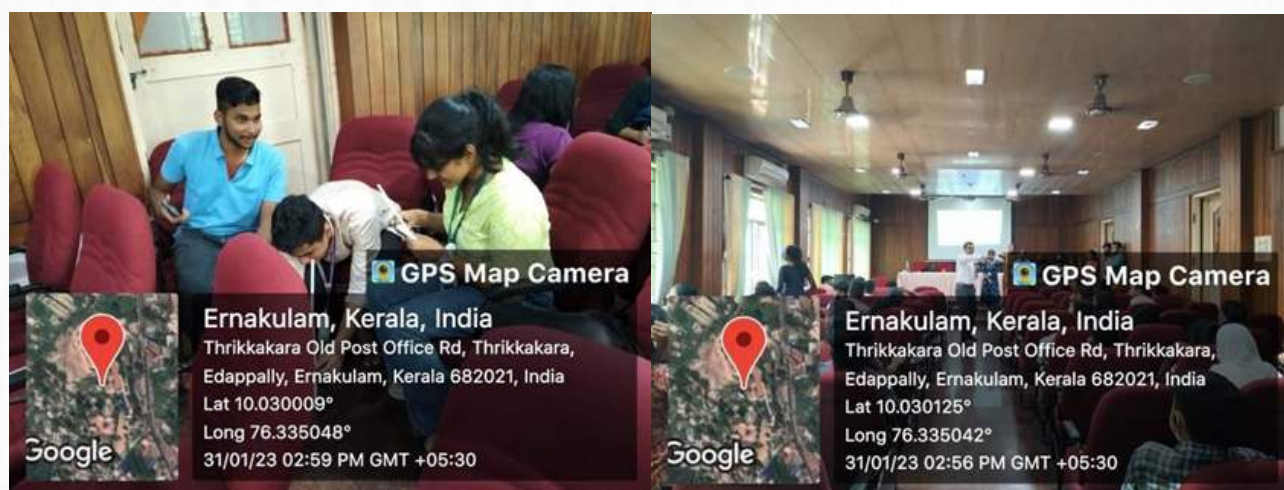

## Placement Orientation Drive

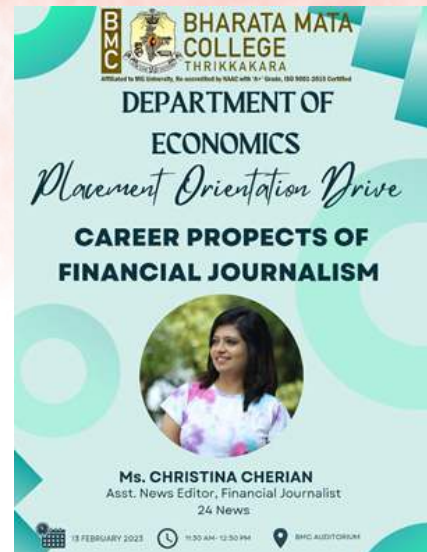

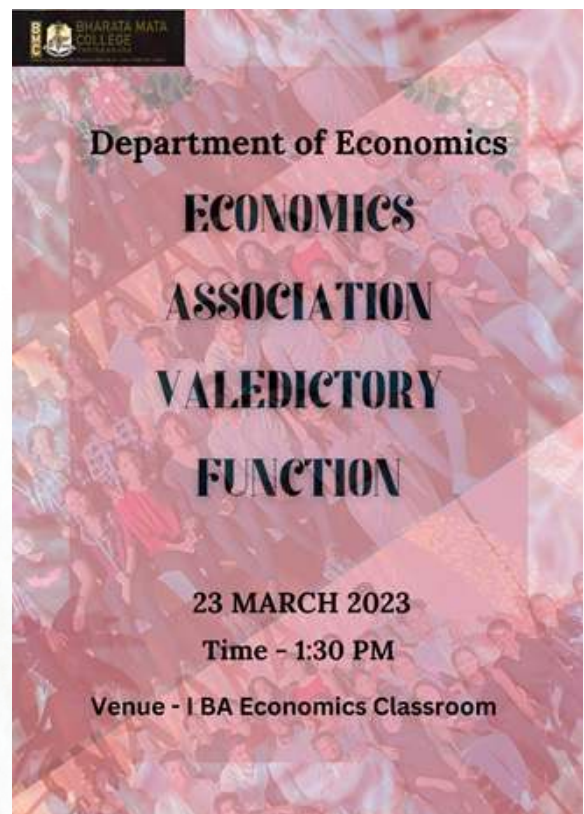

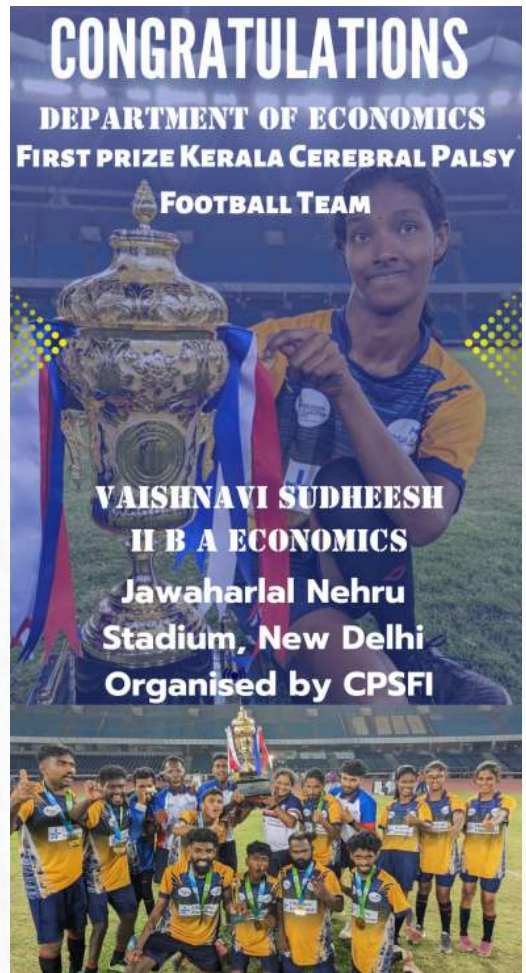
