

Bharata Mata Extension For Organic, Research and Environment (BeFORE) is an outreach wing of Bharata Mata College. BefORE is established in the year 2017. Through BeFORE, we take the opportunity to upgrade our social commitment towards the society and also enrich our interest in networking and involving with the various stake holders for the upliftment of the society. Ever since the date of establishment, BeFORe is actively involving as a change agent in the community through the students and staffs of Bharata Mata college. As a pioneer institution, we understand that it is the duty of the college to stand for the environmental, demographic, socio economical development of the society and are catering to the requirement to the maximum. Since 2017, the contribution of BeFORE could be seen spread in various areas especially towards various women entrepreneurship projects, educational support programmes, research studies, Transgender support programmes, water and sanitation programes etc.

Major objectives of BeFORE are:

- To organize and implement the development projects in the area of education, Health, environment, entrepreneurship, water and sanitation etc.
- To organize projects and conduct training programmes for the development of the marginalized section, SC/ST/Tans gender etc.
- To be a change agent for the student community to think beyond their curriculum, to have a better social outlook and their by uplift the society.

Programmes and activities of BeFORE are carried out by focusing on five sectors which are as follows:

1. In-house activities

Various in-house activities such as agricultural, gardening, workshops, training, awareness programmes, IEC activities etc are conducted in the college which will have positive impact on the students' community.

2. Government funded projects

BeFORE provides more focus to be involved in government funded projects where the college can be directly involved and contributed for the development of the community. At present BeFORE is having three projects in Ernakulam and Thrissur district - Social Impact assessment, Jal Jeevan Mission and TG Sureksha Project .The students from our college get a chance to be placed in these projects.

3. Collaboration with institutions

BeFORE gives more importance to collaborations with various stakeholders like CSR companies, Government Departments, NGOs etc.

4. Internships.

Social work students from Bharata Mata College and other colleges do their internships in the various projects of BeFORE, where they can apply their theoretical knowledge into practice

5. Facilitation

In connection with various stake holders, BeFORE is acting as a facilitator for its beneficiary community in the area of education, employment generation etc.

ACTIVITY REPORT OF THE YEAR 2021-2022

Currently BeFORE has two government funded projects, Jal Jeevan Mission(JJM) and Transgender Sureksha project in collaboration with Kerala Water authority and Kerala State Aids Control Society respectively

I. Jal Jeevan Mission

Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) is envisioned to provide safe and adequate drinking water through individual Functional Household Tap Connections (FHTCs) by 2024 to all households in rural India. JJM is based on a community approach to water and will include extensive Information, Education and Communication as a key component of the mission.

BeFORE has conducted various activities in the adopted panchayath to give awareness and orientation on various aspects of water quality management, water testing, water born diseases etc in connection with JJM.

> Conducted JJM Orientation at Ellamkunnapuzha Panchayath on 19th November 2021.

JJM Orientation session for the panchayath body was conducted at Elamkunnappuzha panchayath conference hall on November 19th 2021. Mr Tony M Tom, Assistant professor, MSW, Bharata Mata College provided the orientation session. The session included the importance of effective IEC activities related to JJM as well as the water related awareness. Apart from Mr Vijay Ghosh, the project leader, various representatives from Kerala Water Authority and Ellamkunnapuzha Panchayath board members were present in the session.



> Water and sanitation awareness class for 'Vayojanakoottayma'

BeFORE in collaboration with Kudumbasree conducted awareness class for vajojanakoottayma (group of elderly people) as a part of Jal Jeevan mission. Session included Awareness on water quality issues, water- borne diseases and health.





> Conducted study for Haritha Karma Sena

A feed study of Haritha Karma Sena at Ellamkunnapuzha Panchayath was conducted with the support of VEO (Haritha Karma Sena in charge) of Mulavukad Panchayat and Kudumbasree CDS, chair person. As part of the study, 160 houses were visited from different wards of the panchayath and data were collected on the efficiency of Haritha Karma Sena in handling the waste management





> Focus group discussion

Several focus group discussions were conducted among school going children. The main aim was to understand the perception of children and to plan more activity based on the feedback assessment.

> FGD on Gender neutrality among the UP and High school students, on 08th January 2022

Conducted focus group discussion on Gender neutrality among the UP and High school students of Ellamkunnapuzha panchayath on 08th January 2022. The programme was to have an understanding on the government policy making regarding the gender neutral uniforms for school children. Selected 7 Girls and 5 boys participated in the discussion.



> FGD on Online education and mobile phone addiction

Conduct a Focus Group Discussion at St. Antonys Church, parish hall on 19th February 2022 for school children on online education and mobile phone addiction. 14 UP high school students actively participated in the discussion.



> FGD on Menstrual Hygiene

Conducted a Focus Group Discussion at St. Antonys Church, parish hall on 19th February 2022 on Menstrual Hygiene for girl's above the age group of 10 and 11 girls participated.



> Snehapoorvam Campaign

Snehapoorvam campaign is a movement started to honour the Covid brigadiers. An appreciation letter was sent to the identified persons who were actively involved during the pandemic period. The programme was conducted at Police station, family health centre and panchayat of Ellamkunnapuzha on 19th February 2022.

> Awareness Classeson Waste Management

From the need assessment study it was highlighted that an awareness session about waste management, water quality issues, water- borne diseases and health needed to be given to the various stake holders of the Udaymperoor panchayath. The awareness classes were conducted in different participant groups including anganwadi teachers, CDS members, Asha workers, MGNREGS groups and SHG groups. The awareness sessions were delivered effectively by

incorporating the participants. The ward members were contacted Before conducting awareness classes in different wards and complete cooperation and assistance were provided by the ward members. Five awareness classes were conducted in different wards.













> Street Play

Street play was conducted on 16'th February 2022, in ward 9, poothotta of udayamperoor panchayath to create awareness among the people about the importance of water, the need to keep it clean and the *Jal Jeevan Mission* Project. Ward member Mr.Kusuman helped to arrange the required facilities. At two o'clock in the afternoon, social work trainees performed street play on the road in front of the anganwadi. People from the anganwadi and kudumbasree members were the audience group. All the social work trainees were participated in the street play.





II. BeFORE-TG Sureksha Project

BeFORE- TG Sureksha is a project funded by Kerala State Aids Control Society (KSACS) which focuses on Sexual Minorities especially Transgender group who

practice risky behaviour, to prevent and control the spread of HIV/AIDS among them and preventing the spread of HIV/AIDS through high risk groups to bridge population and general community. The Project is aimed at behavioural modification among target community, from unsafe sexual practices and injecting practices.

BeFORE Suraksha Project started functioning from 15 April 2021.So far various activities has been conducted in collaboration with government departments, private organizations and individual for the upliftment of the TG community in Thrissur. The total population of TG project in Thrissur is 450.The major activities were as follows,

LIONS CLUB FOOD KITS FOR TG COMMUNITY

Thrissur City Lions Club members sponsor on a monthly basis 10 food kits for our communities who hail from poor background. The beneficiaries also include PLHIVs. Thrissur City Lions club President Mr.Satyan, Secretary Mr.Jayan Mathew and other members also joined the programme and distributed the food kits for the beneficiaries.





COVID VACCINATION CAMP

BeFORE Suraksha TG project arranged Covid vaccination camp for its TG communities in the month of June 2021 in association with Social Justice Department and District Administration at Thrissur Balabhavan. It was a full fledged camp and most of our communities including 55 of them participated in the camp and took covishield vaccination. District Medical Officer Dr.Reena inaugrated the function. Social Justice Department Officer Mr.Ashger Shah provided full support for organizing the camp. The camp was sponsored by ESAF organization.



FOOD KITS SPONSORED BY SOCIAL JUSTICE DEPARTMENT

Food kits for transgender community provided by Social Justice Department (which is issued by Govt of Kerala during Covid pandemic situation) were distributed to 65 transgender community registered with our project on June 7th, 2021. ONLINE STI AWARENESS CLASS FOR TG COMMUNITY

An STI awareness class have been provided for our Transgender Community on June 9th, 2021 by Thrissur Medical College Pulari Counselor Ms.Chithra . Around 30 of our TG community participated in the session. The session dealt with a detailed session about various sexually transmitted infections and their symptoms. The session was very informative for our HRGs.

FOOD KIT SPONSORED BY FATHER DAVID CHIRAMEL

Rev. Father David Chiramel, popularly known as the Kidney Priest, is an Indian Catholic Priest and the founder of the Accident Care and Transport Service (ACTS) and the Kidney

As a part of World AIDS Day 2021, BeFORE Suraksha TG Project coordinated the candle lighting program at Thekkegopura Nada in Thekkinkadu Maidan which is the heart of the town with high visibility of transgenders as well it is most suitable for conveying awareness among mass population.

Thrissur Jilla panchayath President P.K.Davis inaugurated candle lighting program and more than 100 general public and 42 TGs participated. Everybody who was present on the occasion took pledge of the year.

On December 1, as a part of World Aids Day 2021 conducted CBHS Camp and exhibition at North Stand. Respected Health Inspector Mr.Satheesh inaugurated the exhibition. As a part of awareness generation, IEC materials were distributed to general public.

CBHS Camp was inaugurated by duty police officer. 6 direct beneficiaries and 48 indirect beneficiaries were addressed through the camp to know their status of HIV / AIDS.
