Bharata Mata College is a nationally accredited first grade arts and science college established in 1965 by His Eminence the late Joseph Cardinal Parecattil. It is a co-educational institution of higher learning under Bharata Mata Educational Trust owned and managed by the Archdiocese of Ernakulam – Angamaly. The college is affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. The college was included under section 2 (f) and 12 (b) of UGC Act 1956 in 1976 and accredited at the A level by NAAC in 2014.

The college is located in Thrikkakara, the mythological capital of Kerala. It faces the Seaport-Airport Road and is 12 Kms away from the city of Kochi. Despite the semi-urban location of the college, it largely caters to the higher education aspirations of socially, educationally and economically marginalized sections of a rural population belonging to different communities. The college comprises of 2607 students, 127 teachers and 44 members of the non teaching staff. More than 65% of the student community is girls.

Bharata Mata College, which began as a junior college with five Pre degree batches in 1965, offers 17 under graduate courses, 4 post graduate programmes and 2 professional courses. It also comprises of 3 research centres and an off campus centre. The dedication of the management and the community combined with the excellent infrastructural and teaching facilities help maintain high standards in curricular and co-curricular spheres of the college.

In keeping with the lofty vision of its founder, Bharata Mata College is a melting pot of students from all communities and creeds, thus preserving a secular character while promoting the Christian ideal of love and service.

PREFACE



COLLEGE STRATEGIC PLANNING 2018-2021

The present document details the broad initiatives planned by the college for the next three years - from 2018 to 2021. These initiatives have been streamlined according to the seven criteria of NAAC. It details the plans of the management and staff of the college towards delivering high quality educational experiences and opportunities for the students. The planning is decentralized with each department making a distinct plan of its own. This is not meant to be an exhaustive report on the activities, but a reflection of the guidelines for shaping the joint efforts of the entire college community to provide the direction and target for a better future. In this, our plans are detailed, and our hopes unveiled.

1. CURRICULAR ASPECTS

The college has implemented graduate attribute linked course plans which are time bound. New and innovative Add-on courses have been introduced by each department for the students to enhance their skill development. The college is also planning to apply for new UG and PG courses in the next three years.

2. TEACHING -LEARNING AND EVALUATION

We believe in introducing student centric methods, and in implementing new ICT enabled methods of teaching. Emphasis is also on the most effective usage of evaluation techniques. We plan to recruit new qualified faculty for the vacant posts with concurrence from the state government. The teachers who do not possess Ph.D degrees are encouraged to enrol and secure their doctoral degree.

With three research centres (Commerce, Chemistry and Mathematics) and 12 guides, and a total of 252 research publications in the last five years and an award of 22 doctorates, the college promotes the research interests of the teachers and lays major emphasis on research and publications. We hope to have the Department of English to be a new research centre in 2019-20. We are also planning set up a central instrumentation facility to host a range of sophisticated scientific instruments, which can be accessed by students and researchers from other colleges and institutes to facilitate collaborative research.

4. INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING RESOURCES

The Management is keen on upgrading and maintaining the existing infrastructure facilities of the college. Recently, a state -of -the -art Audio Visual Conference Hall was constructed and the Principal's Office was modernised. Renovation of the auditorium and rain water harvesting system, setting up of a new computer centre are some of the projects that will be taken up in the next three years. The emphasis is also on building good infrastructure facility to augment the sports and physical educational facilities of the students.

STUDENTS' HALL

A modern Students' Amenities Hall is to be constructed to conduct student activities like department meetings and association programmes.

AUDITORIUM

Though Bharata Mata College has an auditorium with a total seating capacity of 1500, the stage needs maintenance and the adjacent green rooms are insufficient. A sum of Rs. 50 lakhs will be utilized for the overall renovation including necessary toilet facilities and green rooms. The existing balcony is proposed to be converted into a Seminar Hall.

RAIN WATER HARVESTING SYSTEM

Renovation of the existing Rain Water Harvesting System is a proposal laid down to be materialized in 2018-19. Two tanks of 5.6 mtrs diameter and 4.2 mtrs height, each with 1,00,000 litres capacity is to be constructed.

P.G. BLOCK

The P.G. block will be set up in 2019-20.

M.S.W BLOCK

A new M.S.W Block will be constructed by 2020-21 near the SBI bank.

COMPUTER CENTRE

Though the departments have individual computer labs and has access to the internet and other facilities, there is a need to set up a central facility. A Computer Centre with 50 computers will be set up in 2018-19.

Another computer centre with 50 computers is to be set up in 2019-20.

NEW CAFETERIA

The college canteen which was constructed in 1965 and renovated and expanded in 2011 when the student strength was less, finds it difficult to cater to the present day needs, where the number of students has risen to around 2600. Hence a three storey 5400 sq.ft. cafeteria with two dining halls will be constructed in the year 2019, near the MBA block to solve the problem.

EXAM HALL

The existing exam hall with the capacity of 500 students will be renovated and expanded in 2018-19.

PROPOSALS IN THE SPORTS ARENA

In the coming three years, a better focus will be given to the development of sports facilities and modernisation of the sports amenities. The amount allocated for each is listed below.

New Cricket pitch: 1 Lakh Indoor Sports Area: 10 lakhs

Concrete Basket Ball Court: 5 lakhs

A new 400 mts. running track will also be constructed.

GIRLS RETIRING ROOM

A retiring hall for girl students is to be set up. Those unwell and in need of rest may take a break and relax in this room.

LIBRARY

The barcode technology is slowly getting replaced by the RFID (Radio Frequency Identification) technology in libraries across the globe to speed up the self check in/out processes, to control theft and to ease the inventory control in library.

Major changes envisaged for implementation in the College Central Library is RFID based Library Management system (LMS) which would allow fast transaction flow and will prove immediate and long term benefits in traceability and security.

7. INNOVATIONS AND BEST PRACTICES

WASTE SEGREGATION

As part of implementing the green protocol, the waste will be segregated into three different coloured waste bins (Red for Plastic, Yellow for Paper and Green for Food Waste) and the plastic and the paper waste will be recycled and the food waste will be converted to manure for use in our fields.

GREEN AUDIT

A green audit will be conducted in 2018-19, as a tool for attaining sustainable development.

WATER AUDIT

The rain water harvesting system with a total capacity of 2,00,000 litres should suffice to meet the daily water requirement of students and this will minimize the dependence of the community on other water sources. A water audit will be conducted to analyse the requirement of water usage.

ENERGY AUDIT

An energy audit will also be conducted to find the feasibility of installing solar powered electrical appliances and to reduce the energy consumption needs of the college.

ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY

Our campus is a plastic-free environmental-friendly zone wherein great efforts are put to instil the values of environmental consciousness among the student community. In-house activities like implementation of green protocol, waste segregation, reduction of plastic usage are a part of the campus culture.

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Besides NGOs associated with each department, we have a registered NGO BeFORE (Bharata Mata Extension For Organic, Research and Environment) for extending outreach activities towards society. Students from other institutes will also be included for internships here

We have already adopted three cluster colonies (Vadakkekara, Thiruthipuram and Vellottumpadam) and 2 panchayats (Kuttanpuzha and Udayamperoor) for our activites.
